

4-H Checklist

Suggestions & helpful hints only

- Stall decorations are optional Theme is ...Famous Duos... please keep the aisle open and decorations secured and out of horses reach / no staples or nails will be allowed on stall doors or walls
- Tack Box w/ lock (no trailers will be allowed around barn but can be parked in East Parking lot)
- Water pail – rope or trailer tie works to hang in stall (Double End Snaps for D-Ring)
- Feed pail or tub
- Grain / Hay
- Hay bag if desired (Keep full or take out of stall)
- Apple Picker / Manure Fork
- Wheelbarrow or muck tub
- Rake / Sprinkler can (dust control)
- Pine Shavings (will be available for \$5 a bale)
- Brushes, curry's, mane combs, hoof pick, scissors, tote, towels & rags, etc.
- Shampoo, Conditioners, wash mitt, bucket, hose, spray nozzle, etc.
- Slinky & horse sheet
- Clippers – if possible ... best to have this done at home so that all you need to do is final touch up.
- Hair polishes – if desired
- Fly spray
- Hoof polishes – Tip from farrier --pledge will shine hooves for short term and is not damaging to hoof, doesn't stain either
- Braiding / Banding supplies (if you need help ... please plan ahead ... there are many people that will be happy to help ... ask and you shall receive!)
- Show Halter (clean) – Nylon or Leather w/ chain lead to match if possible (not mandatory to have silver on leather halters)
- Saddles -- cleaned & ready to go – double-check your billets and straps
- Portable saddle rack – comes in handy if you have one
- Bridles – cleaned & ready to go – might want to have extra set of reins
- Bits – be sure they are approved for 4-H (look in Indiana 4-H Handbook)
- Girths – Be sure they're safe & clean
- Extra Chicago screws & screwdriver (always seem to get lost at the most inopportune times)
- Show clothes –
 - English – approved helmet, breeches, shirt w/ collar pin, jacket, belt, boots, gloves, etc.
 - Western – approved helmet, jeans, long sleeve shirt with collar, belt, boots, chaps are optional, gloves, vest or jacket, etc.
 - Contesting – approved helmet, jeans, long sleeve shirt with collar, belt, boots, etc.
- FOR GIRLS – Hair accessories (for clean, neat appearance)
- Smiles & good attitudes – always make the week go better! Have a GREAT week!
