• A committee member will be available at the fairgrounds from 6-7:30 pm each of these nights to sign members up for work schedules/fair classes, hand in activity packets, pay the \$18.00 shavings fee, pay any unpaid dues, clear up any last minute confusions, and answer any last minutes questions you might have. Please bring the forms included with this letter to the entry booth. If you do not attend one of these nights, you will be placed last on the list for stall selection.

### Pre 4-H Fair Week

#### Monday July 3rd @ 5:30

• The Fairgrounds asks that all 4-H families come out and lend a hand getting the grounds ready for the fair.

### Wednesday July 5th @ 6:00

- Please come out and help us place shaving in the stalls and clean up the barn.
- Pizza Dinner 6:00 pm @ the Cowboy Kitchen. Provided by the Horse and Pony Club.
- We will be sharing essential information regarding the upcoming fair week, making stall selections, handing out t-shirts and taking the group picture. 4-Hers may begin decorating their stalls at this meeting if they wish.

• Tack stalls will be assigned this night as well. We should have enough tack stalls so that we can have 3-4 people per tack stall. Tack boxes can also be placed in the aisle as long as they do not block the aisle in any way.

### **4-H Fair Week**

#### Friday, July 7th

Horses/ponies may start entering @ 6pm-10pm.

### Saturday, July 8th

- All animals must be stalled by 12 Noon. The 4-H member or a parent/guardian will need to be at the stall at 12:00 noon for a wellness/stall check.
- There will be an arena schedule for practice times posted in the barn and one is included in this packet.
- We will be setting up the jumps at 8pm for Sunday morning's practice. It is mandatory to help set up jumps for those participating. Thank you for your cooperation.

### Sunday, July 9th

- Parade Line Up @ 3:30pm on the North side of H&P Barn. We will need several parents to walk along with us. The JR Committee will lead our group with the Hoyer's draft horses and wagon. Expected attire is helmets (for those riding horses), boots, jeans, and the 2023 Horse & Pony T-shirt.
- A kid/adult wiffle ball game will start at 6pm or after the group returns from the parade.
- There will be no horse workouts during this time.
- We will be setting up the jumps at 8pm after the game for Monday morning's practice. It is mandatory to help set up jumps for those participating. Thank you for your cooperation.

### Tuesday, July 11 - Western Show Day @ 9am

- If you will be hauling in a second horse project, please be courteous to the kids showing and be on the grounds and parked by 9:00 am if possible. Please park along the fence on the south side.
- We will be taking winners pictures throughout the day. Winners please go to the winner circle up by the wash rack after each class to get your picture taken.

### Wednesday, July 12- English Show Day @ 9 am

- If you will be hauling in a second horse project, please be courteous to the kids showing and be on the grounds and parked by 9:00 am if possible. Please park along the fence on the south side.
- We will be taking winners pictures throughout the day. Winners please go to the winner circle up by the wash rack after each class to get your picture taken.

### Thursday, July 13 - Speed Show Day @ 3pm

- If you will be hauling in a second horse project, please be courteous to the kids showing and be on the grounds and parked by 3pm if possible. Please park along the fence on the south side.
- We will be taking winners pictures throughout the day. Winners please go to the winner circle up by the wash rack after each class to get your picture taken.
- In recognition of our graduating horse & pony seniors, we will honor them and their parents in a ceremony held at 6 pm or after the current class in the arena. Ceremony will be held in the arena. Graduating seniors will be asked to fill out a questionnaire about themselves if they did not turn anything into the extension office.

### Friday July 14

- Don't forget to cast your vote for the most helpful "2022 Senior Horse & Pony Member."
- All Around Showmanship horse classes will be in the arena at 4 pm. We will need 9 horses for this event, please let a committee member know if you would be willing to let a premier showman use your horse. They will need to be clean & ready to show 30 minutes prior to the class starting. Arena will need to be closed @ 3:30 until after All Around Showmanship leaves
- The Fun Show will be this evening starting at 5pm. Helmets will be required.
- Horses can be released after 12:00 am. Your horse and tack stall needs to be cleaned and inspected by the barn manager or committee member before being released. If stalls are not cleaned, you will lose your incentive awards.

### Saturday July 15th

• Horses/Ponies released 12:00am-12:00pm. Your horse and tack stall needs to be cleaned and inspected by the barn manager or committee member before being released. All animals must be out of the barn by Noon.

### **Monday July 17th**

• 4-H Fairgrounds clean up @ 5:00 pm.

#### **Barn Rules**

- No staples, screws, nails or tape allowed on stall walls or doors. No metal on metal is permitted. If you would like to use metal hooks in your tack stall, the hooks may be wrapped in vet wrap so there is no metal on metal. We suggest zip ties or string.
- No riding in the barn.
- Do not tie horses in an aisle. Aisle ways must be kept clear at all times.
- Boots must be worn any time you are working with your horse. (Including cleaning stalls)
- The secondary project may be brought to the grounds and returned home the day of the 4-H Fair show. Secondary projects must stay at their respective trailer or they may take the place of the stalled (primary) project. An Adult Horse & Pony Committee Member and/or Barn Manager MUST be made aware prior to secondary project taking the place of primary project in barn. No more than one project in the barn at one time.
- Do not put any manure or shaving bags in trash cans. Empty shaving bags need to be placed in the receptacle at the west end of the barn.
- Barn will close at 11 pm or 1 hour following any horse show.
- Helmets and boots must be worn at all times when mounted or driving horse/pony.
- There will be no riding double or riding bareback until Friday.
- Round pen may be used, but limit time to 10 minutes if there is a line waiting. You may go back to the end of the line for a second turn. Horses are not permitted in the round pen unattended.
- 2 Water buckets must hang at horse's chest height
- If using a hay bag, they must hang at horse's wither height and removed once empty
- Feed buckets/pans must be removed once empty
- Halters must be on horses at all times while in the stall.
- Decorations need to be secure so that horses can't tamper with them (Lights are prohibited)
  - This will be the last year (2023) we will be doing hangout stalls if they are not better taken care of.
    - We suggest locking your stall when not in use, show days, and nights during lights out @ 11pm.
    - Be Careful who you choose to share a stall with as it is your responsibility to take care of it.

<sup>\*</sup>Horses must be kept at a walk unless in the arena or make up arena.

### **Stall Inspections**

- Stall inspection will be as follows:
  - Saturday 5:00 pm
  - Sunday 9:00 am and 2:00 pm before parade
  - Monday 9:00 am and 5:00 pm
  - Tuesday Show Day 5 p.m. or one hour following the end of show.
  - Wednesday Show Day 5 p.m. or one hour following the end of show.
  - Thursday Show Day 9:00 am
  - Friday Fun Show- 9 am and 5 pm
- Please find an adult committee member to buy shavings \$6 per bag
- Stall inspection will be evaluated on the following:
  - 0 pts to 4 pts per stall check. One point awarded for each of the following:
    - -2 full water buckets
    - animal fed
    - bedding cleaned
    - front of stall and tack stall tidy

If you only complete two of those then you will only receive two points.
